# 5 WAYS TO GIVE TO CO-MISSION

We continue to make every effort to serve the overseas missionaries we sponsor. That is what this ministry is all about—helping those who are reaching their own people with the Gospel of Christ.

But we also serve you—those who give to help the missionaries we sponsor.

In our on-going ministry to serve you, and be the best stewards we can possibly be, we have developed several ways to make it convenient for you to give to CO-Mission International.

- 1 **Direct Giving:** The life blood of CO-Mission continues to be YOU who regularly send your gifts to us in the return envelope enclosed with each monthly newsletter. About 95% of our funds come to us through our newsletter.
- 2 **Bank draft:** Every bank operates differently, so you'll need to talk to your bank to find out their procedure. It works something like this. You fill out a form with your bank asking them to write a check each month to CO-Mission International. They will mail us a check in your name, drawn from your account.
- 3 **Credit card:** Again, each company operates differently, but it works something like this. Call your credit card company and request the proper form. On the form you designate a certain amount you want contributed to CO-Mission each month. Return the form and they will automatically charge your card, and send the funds directly to CO-Mission.
- 4 **Pay-Pal:** This is a more direct way to give with your credit card. Go to [www.comission.com](http://www.comission.com), click "Contribute," click "Donate on-line," click the Visa/Mastercard button. Follow the Pay-Pal instructions. Pay-Pal charges the donation to your credit card and sends all but a very small percentage to CO-Mission. Pay-Pal emails you a receipt.
- 5 **Amazon.com:** This is a great way to give to CO-Mission, without it costing you *anything*. With Christmas approaching, you will be purchasing gifts for friends and loved ones. If you shop at Amazon.com, go to [www.comission.com](http://www.comission.com) and click on the "Contribute" link. Then enter Amazon's store. They have a lot of great books, music, Bibles—just about anything you need. Amazon will donate about 5% of your purchase to CO-Mission.
